Dr. Franco Jean-Louis, M.D. is a surgeon, licensed educator, and former director of operations for a large Haitian orphanage. He knows firsthand the plight of his people; he, too, was raised in a Haitian orphanage.

Dr. Franco has been a missionary medical doctor since 1995, answering God's call to improve the lives of the next generation of Haitians in need.



In the aftermath of the earthquake a year ago, conditions in Haiti have deteriorated, especially for its children and their families

Dr. Franco is responding to this crisis by creating Generation of Hope, Haiti ([Go Haiti](http://www.go-haiti.org)) www.go-haiti.org. This non-profit organization is committed to reaching the lost and poor of Haiti, especially abandoned children and the sick. His goal remains constant: to meet the physical and the spiritual needs of the Haitian people.



God has already provided a parcel of property which will serve as the primary location of Generation of Hope. It is a two acre site that is in a very strategic and accessible location in the community; 10 to 15 minutes from the airport, and in the vicinity of both the American Embassy and the United Nations base. This property is also adjacent to a refugee camp / tent city that regularly receives food, medical clinics and cholera education from Dr. Franco.

On the property is an existing building that is in need of considerable rehabilitation. Once this primary site is renovated, it will serve as a multipurpose facility: orphanage; early childhood development center; primary school and trade school. This effort will include the construction of a fence around the property's perimeter; installing proper windows; and updating some of the structure's wiring. **The overall estimate to finish the house and make it ready for children is forty thousand dollars.**



Generation of Hope has already connected to city power; has abundant running water; and installed beautiful bathrooms with conventional running water and flushing toilets.
